FOUNTAINS

As you will be aware, the fountain in Westbourne Avenue has now been repaired and restored and is now standing, fully painted.

Bollards are to be placed in the planted area shortly.

The Park Avenue one is in the hands of the City Council Solicitor who is chasing the insurance company.

This is one of 7 fountains placed in the Avenues and Boulevard in 1880 and were working until approx 1914/15 when they were turned into gardens. For reasons of increased traffic, the two on Princes Avenue were removed. No-one knows what happened to the other 3 - do you?

A lottery bid is in place to replace the ones in Victoria and Marlborough Avenues.

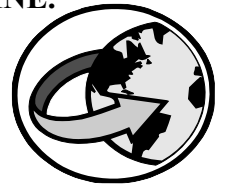
