Photocopying Service

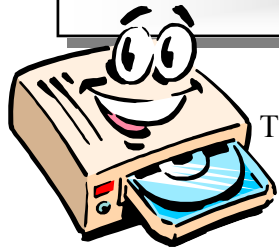
We have a new service to offer residents:
